

St. Michael Parish Pastoral Council

July 27, 2009 Minutes

Attendees: Fr. John Fischer, Deacon Ken DeHanes, Jim Konves, Tom Jansing, Susan Bailey, Jason Sauer, Lori Ann Fothergill, Bob Letourneau, Brenda Kuhr, Alan Heilers, Diana Gloyd & Brian Bisig

Fr. John presented his pastor's report. We added six households (28 people) & lost four families. Fr. John noted that there has been an increase in people requesting confessions.

Jim Konves gave an update on the 90th Anniversary plans. 120 people have signed up for the dance (Jim is planning for 200). Three TV stations want to cover the parish saying the rosary around the church property. Jim is arranging this. Jim will get a proclamation from political entities on the 90th anniversary celebration.

Deacon Ken DeHanes reported that the class on Child Protection is good once you have passed until the requirements are changed. Finger printing is required for each new job working with children (note you can list all the jobs you think you will be doing and they will be covered under one finger printing. Deacon DeHanes has been appointed to St. Michael as our deacon.

Susan Bailey reported that she is going back to school and will not be available for Monday meetings.

Lori Fothergill reported that the parish directories will be out sometime, they are at the printers. Lori has reviewed and corrected the directories 4 times so far. Lori still needs 4 full time catechists for the coming year. Catechists have a 3 step certification process.

Jason Sauer noted that this is his last year as Parish Pastoral president. Jim Konves is set to take over next June. Bob Letourneau announced that he is likely to be moving to Columbus in the near future and will therefore be vacating his seat on Council as well as the post of Secretary. PPC members are encouraged to consider taking over this role.

We need someone from Council to take leadership of the communication/Leadership Day activities as well as discernment for 2010.

The next Parish Pastoral Council meeting is scheduled for October 12th. The meeting will begin with Evensong at 7:00 in the church.
